These grants offer an invaluable opportunity for **PhD students** to engage with international networks, interact with the global community of researchers, and deepen their understanding of local governance dynamics.

Details:

1. **Travel grants.** Two travel grants of 750 euros each are being offered to support participation in the Summer School of Local Government and Politics.
2. **Summer School Benefits:** The Summer School provides a platform for young scholars to immerse themselves in discussions, workshops, and networking sessions focused on various aspects of local government. Participants will have the opportunity to engage with international scholars and practitioners, fostering meaningful connections and expanding their professional horizons.
3. **Priority for Non-EU Students.** Priority consideration will be given to students from outside the European Union, emphasizing our commitment to promoting international diversity and inclusivity in academic exchange.
4. **Other expenses covered** by the Summer School. The organization covers accommodation, all lunches and one dinner. The Summer School does not charge fee for participation.

Application Deadline: The deadline for applications is the **5th of May**.
